Crans Montana Forum Panel: "After the Arab Spring – The 'Arab Winter' and Global Security: Impact on Security in the Maghreb, the Mediterranean, and Europe"

On Friday 19 October 2012, Dr Mohammad-Mahmoud Ould Mohamedou, Head of the Regional Capacity Development Programme and Senior Fellow, chaired a high-level panel on "After the Arab Spring — The 'Arab Winter' and Global Security: Impact on Security in the Maghreb, the Mediterranean, and Europe" as part of the Crans Montana Forum, which was held at the Intercontinental Hotel in Geneva.
